She wrote the only craft book of its kind, *The Ekphrastic Writer: Creating Art-Influenced Poetry, Fiction and Nonfiction*, and has served as a long-time assistant editor at *Boulevard* magazine. She has been featured on Seattle Channel TV and at the Library of Congress, won the 2023 Dorset Prize from Tupelo Press for *The Andrew Wyeth Chronicles*, and received a 2024–2025 City Artist grant from the Seattle Office of Arts & Culture.
